The VSAVA and MSD Animal Heath are dedicated to preserving and improving the health and well-being of companion animals as well as honouring exceptional veterinary students by providing \$5,000 in financial support to 2nd and 3rd year veterinary students. Two scholarships in amount of \$2,500 each will be awarded. All class of 2016 and 2017 veterinary students are encouraged to apply.

Student Requirements:

- Currently enrolled in the 2nd or 3rd year veterinary students (promotion of 2016 and 2017) at the Faculty of Animal Science and Veterinary Medicine Nong Lam University Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam.
- Base on Grade Point Average (GPA), the student must on the top 10 of class
- Be a VSAVA member (not obligation)
- Not have previously held a MSD Animal Health VSAVA Veterinary Student Scholarship
- Merit based with some consideration to financial need
- Social activity, volunteering, or having a certificate of Indigence and Low Income family, or family in/under preferential treatment policy (optional) will be aslo taken into account

Submit a complete application with all endorsements and attachments by the closing date.

Terms and Conditions:

- Only eligible applicants, and applications, will be considered
- Applicant must be willing to contribute at least 100 hours per year of volunteer service in a small veterinary field for two years after receiving the MSD Animal Health -VSAVA scholarship

Please note that in each round the number of well qualified applicants greatly outnumbers the scholarships available. Each applicant is judged by the members of the Selection Committees in relation to all the other candidates who have applied in a particular round's competion, and relative judgments must be made given the facts at hand.

 and/or within your work experience.
- Your curriculum vitae
- One recommendation letter
- Your certification of Rank and Grade Point Average (GPA)
- Supporting documents, e.g. certificate, awards, etc.
